PIPING and DRUMMING AWARDS

All prizes, medals, and cash awards in individual piping and drumming will be awarded according to the following:

1 or 2 competitors.....1 award
 3 competitors.....2 awards
 4 to 10 competitors.....3 awards
 11 to 15 competitors.....4 awards
 16 to 20 competitors.....5 awards
 More than 20 competitors.....6 awards

Aggregate trophies will be awarded in the individual piping classes. Engraving of perpetual trophies is the responsibility of the winners.

PIPE BAND TRAVEL ASSISTANCE

Travel assistance will be offered to the first ten (10) bands entered with the following arrangements; bands traveling 150-299 miles one way will receive \$300, those traveling more than 300 miles one way will receive \$1000. To qualify for travel assistance, pipe band requests must be post-marked by the above deadline

PIPING, DRUMMING AND BAND RULES

1. Individual piping, drumming and pipe band events are conducted in accordance with the rules prescribed by the British Columbia Piper's Association. For information, see the Association's Internet Web Site at www.bcpipers.org or contact the piping and drumming registrar show above.

2. Individual pipers, drummers and pipe band members must be attired in recognizable Highland dress. Dress for bands must be of a conforming nature.
3. Competitors in individual piping and drumming events play in reverse order of entry (Last to enter will be first to play). The Games committee reserves the right to revise the order of play at its discretion. The orders of play will be posted at www.phga.org 1 week before the Games and outside the Piping & Drumming Tally tent. Each competitor will be expected to immediately follow the preceding player or be disqualified. Competitors may exchange positions with other competitors only with the permission of the Chief Steward.
4. Open Piobaireachd: Competitors must submit a list of 4 tunes with their entry. Competitors will be notified of the judges' choice of tune approximately 20 minutes before competitor's scheduled starting time.
5. Pipe bands will consist of minimum numbers per the British Columbia Pipers' Association pipe band rules.
6. Pipers and drummers are to tune and warm up in designated areas only.
7. No piping or drumming is allowed during the Welcoming Ceremonies without the express permission of the platform steward.
8. The pipe band events order of play will be drawn 3 weeks prior to the Games and posted at www.phga.org 1 week before the Games.
9. All competing bands will be required to play in Massed Bands, and will be paid \$100 for satisfactory participation. The Portland Highland Games Association attaches considerable importance to this event as an obligation to the spectators. Bands failing to participate fully or maintain deportment standards acceptable to the Piping and Drumming Chairman will have travel assistance, prize money and the \$100 Massed Bands participation fees withheld.
10. **Notice to all Pipe Bands.** Due to US IRS regulations, PHGA is required to collect tax identification information for all bands. All pipe bands must complete and submit IRS form W-9 along with their entry. Foreign competitors, must complete and submit IRS form W-8BEN along with their entry. Forms can be obtained either from WWW.IRS.GOV, or can be found within the WWW.PHGA.ORG website. Please see form instructions.
11. **Notice to all Open Piping and Drumming Prize Winners.** Due to US IRS regulations, PHGA is required to collect tax identification information for Open Piping and Drumming prize winners. We will have the appropriate IRS forms available on the day of the Games. Prize monies will not be distributed without completion of the appropriate IRS form. The forms are the same as those above but will be collected at prize pickup time. Please prepare accordingly for the completion of the required IRS forms.
12. **No field entries will be allowed.**
13. **No band challenge ups will be allowed in 2019.**
